

Player Agent

- Teams formed approx. 2
 weeks after registration closes
- Lower divisions: consider school, age, etc.
- Upper divisions: attend skills evaluation Feb. 27 & 28



Coach Coordinator



- Assign coaches for each team
- Provide training for coaches
- Help ensure competitive balance

Managers, Coaches

- Managers: In charge of practice schedule
- Managers: Responsible for coordinating all team activities and volunteer roles
- Coaches: Responsible for assisting manager in running team
- Goal is for coaches to co-manage as much as possible



Team Parent

 Helps manager communicate with parents (e.g., coordinate team volunteers)



The Umpire – <u>Best</u> Seat in the House



- A fun way to stay in the game
- Necessary to help make sure the game is fair
- Each team provides an umpire for each game (best to have two on your team)
- We provide training (both on rules and best practices)
- CLL has a strict behavioral code that everyone (players, coaches, and especially spectators) will abide by and respecting the umpire is part of that

Field Maintenance – Saturday, April 3

- One day, start of season!
- Set up fields to be playable
- Assemble, install fences



Pre-game Field Prep



- Raking base cutouts
- Chalking batter boxes, foul lines
- Recommend 2 volunteers per team

Scorekeeper



- Two recommended for each minor and major team
- Official book home team
- Training clinic

Safety, Team Safety Parent



- Ensure team has first aid supplies
- Reports injuries to CLL Safety Office Text
- CLL Insurance
